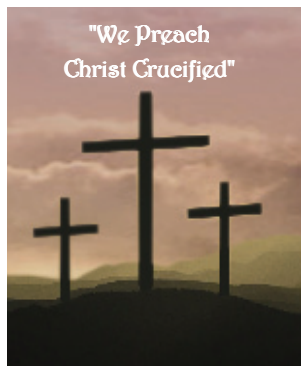

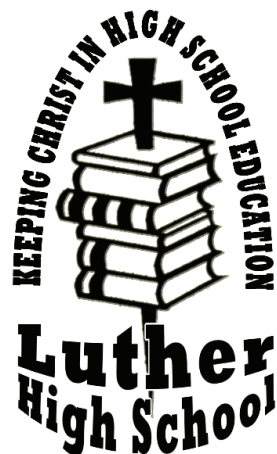

## 7RRC Robotics Scrimmage

You are invited to a robotics event at Luther High School. igKnighthion Team 4021 is proud to host our third Seven Rivers Robotics Coalition (7RRC) scrimmage. The event will take place on Sunday, February 21, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Admission is free and concessions will be available.

This year's game, "Stronghold", is a medieval themed game played by two alliances of three robots on each alliance. Robots score points by crossing their opponents' defenses, scor-

ing boulders (foam balls) in their opponents' tower, or surrounding and scaling their opponents' tower. This game requires knowledge of many areas of academics including science, technology, mathematics and engineering. Over 20 teams have been invited to the scrimmage.
